AVAILABLE TICKETS

For July 3, 2007, there are only thirty tickets (30) available!

For July 4, 2007, there are only eight (8) tickets available!

FOOD CHOICES

There are four options to choose from, including:

- 1) Vegetarian (Manicotti w/Ricotta Cheese)
- 2) Prime Rib of Beef (Au Jus)
- 3) Baked White Fish (Alaskan Pollack)
- 4) Baked Chicken (Chicken Champagne)

All of the meals come with the Riverboat Tossed Salad w/ Parmesan Vinaigrette Dressing, Potato or Rice, Seasonal Vegetables, Fresh Rolls & Butter, Chef's Special Dessert, and Coffee & Iced Tea. There is a cash bar available for soda & alcohol.

CHILDREN

CRUISE DETAILS

1) Boarding Time: 6:30 p.m., Cruising Time: 7:00 p.m., Dinner Served: 7:00 p.m., Return to Dock: 9:00 p.m., Fireworks Display: 9:30 p.m. You can choose to stay on the boat or go out on the dock to watch the fireworks display until 10 p.m.

The captain of the Riverboat Cruise determines the exact direction and distance of the cruise. Typically, the boat cruises north, then south, and then loops back around to the dock. At 9 p.m., the boat will come in to dock so they can shut down river traffic for the fireworks display. The boat will be stationary from that point on.
